### **St. Blaise BLESSING OF THROATS**


The blessing of throats with a pair of candles (blessed on the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord) in the shape of a cross is a sacramental which takes place on the Feast of St Blaise (3rd of February). The tradition is based on the story of how St Blaise saved the life of a boy who had a fishbone stuck in his throat by ordering the child to cough it up. The mother of the boy gifted St Blaise with candles as a sign of appreciation. We will have the blessing of throats at the end of the **7.00 am Mass on Tuesday 3/2/2026**.


